

Jewellery Policy

This policy aims at establishing guidelines on safe working practices. MMH takes very seriously its duty of care to ensure the Health and Safety of its employees in a manner that minimises the risk, both to the employee and contractors operating on site.

The wearing of jewellery is not permitted at the workplace where the work activity involves any risk from wearing jewellery.

- The wearing of finger rings, earrings and facial jewellery is prohibited;
- The wearing of bracelets and necklaces is prohibited in the workplace; the only exception is for medical bracelets which should be of the 'open copper' type;
- Where other jewellery is worn, such as that associated with body piercing, this is only permitted where the jewellery is continuously and completely covered by clothing such as coveralls or jackets;
- Wrist watches must be removed when working with moving equipment and machinery

All third parties operating on site are to adhere with this policy.
