

# Weapons, Firearms, Knives and Pointed Objects Policy



The Mediterranean Maritime Hub is a port facility regulated both by the Laws of Malta and the International Ship and Port Facility Security Code. Therefore, in line with Chapter 480 of the Maltese Legislation, no weapons, knives or pointed objects intended to cause damage or harm to persons and/or property are allowed within the boundaries of this port facility. Moreover, MMH is committed to provide a safe work environment to all its employees, clients, contractors, visitors and crews therefore the carrying of weapons, knives or pointed objects that can inflict harm on other persons is strictly prohibited.

Should a person intend to introduce any equipment or tool/s that could be classified as weapons or knives so to facilitate his work activity, then these items are to be declared beforehand at the Site Surveillance office. Authority to allow these items inside the facility will be given by MMH management only after due controls and verification that same have the required safety features and the operator is certified to handle this equipment.

The carrying of knives within MMH is solely restricted to the respective place of duty and nonetheless, this item needs to be declared upon arrival at the Site Surveillance office.

In line with ISPS regulations, MMH management reserves the right to conduct searches on every person entering or leaving the facility to ensure strictest adherence to this policy.
